



DUNHILL COMPENDIUM PARKA

Introducing the dunhill Compendium Parka. A new outerwear concept giving more value to timeless design.

Inspired by a utilitarian, multi-functional men's compact found in the dunhill Archive, this unique object featured different practical tools in miniature, including a cigarette case, pocket-knife, lighter and watch, amongst others.

At the heart of the Autumn Winter 2021 collection, the dunhill Compendium Parka is a versatile garment that can be worn in various ways. The coat can be zipped away to become a jacket, its lining detached to become a separate piece in its own right.

Comprising four distinct components, including the main shell and three interchangeable liners – each element is a different weight and fabrication, allowing for adaptability with the changing seasons. A Rolla Quilt Short Liner, Double Faced Cashmere Liner or Reversible Shearling Hooded Liner can be attached one at a time to the inside of the Shell Parka, to build the desired coat.

Eco-conscious materials have been considered, including a regenerated nylon made from waste materials such as fishing nets, carpets and fabric, alongside an innovative, animal friendly shearling. Pioneered as part of the Reversible Hooded Liner, it is created by shearing the wool from the sheep and weaving the fibres into a recycled polyester base. Maintaining the appearance of traditional shearling, it is also extremely lightweight, improving performance.

Through the creation of one garment that fulfils many needs, emphasis is placed on longevity over disposability. Realized in luxurious yet practical materials; utility, function and elegance find form in one everlasting, yet always changing item.

Launching from mid-October 2021, prices range from: £895 - £1,995 / €995 - €2,295 / \$1,195 - \$2,695.
